


The Darkness

Isaiah 59:1-2



- Sin separates us from God.
- To have a relationship with God the wall must be broken down.
- The point in time sin is forgiven is the point in time of salvation.

Romans 3:23-25



- Who has sinned? Everyone.
- All are equally lost. A "good moral life" can't save you.
- The Grace of God saves us through faith in the blood of Jesus.

Galatians 5:19-21, 2 Timothy 3:1-5, James 4:17

- What is sin?

- What is the eternal consequence of sin?
- There are just two alternatives.

Coming Into the Light

Acts 2:22-41

- What message did they believe? (v. 22-36)
 - Jesus is from God & rose physically from the dead.
 - o Personal responsibility for the death of Jesus.
 - Jesus is both Lord and Christ (Eph. 2:8, Romans 10:9,10).
- What was their response? (v.37-41)
 - Out to the heart What should we do?
 - O Repentance (Luke 13:3-5, 2 Corinthians 7:10-11)
 - o Baptism (John 3:1-5, 1 Peter 3:20-21)
 - o They responded immediately.
- What did they receive?
 - o Forgiveness of sins (Acts 22:16).
 - o The Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13-14).
