

GIVING WITH YOUR BANK ACCOUNT

1. ENTER DONATION INFORMATION

On our giving page, you can give a one-time gift or set up a recurring donation.

A. Add the donation amount and choose the fund you want to give to.

If you want to split your donation between two or more funds, click Add donation to choose another fund.

B. If you decide to give regularly, choose the frequency of the donation and the date that the recurring donation starts.

C. Click “continue” to choose your payment method

2. CHOOSE YOUR PAYMENT METHOD

After entering your donation information, you can choose to log in to access payment methods you've saved in the past, or to add a new bank account or debit/credit card for your donation.



3. GIVE THROUGH YOUR BANK ACCOUNT

When giving with a bank account for the first time:

- You will have to verify that you own the bank account.
- Your account is saved to your profile so that you won't have to verify account ownership every time you give.



Verification shows that you have access to the bank account you are connecting, that you have given permission to withdraw money, and they've connected the correct account.

A. Click verify account


- There are two ways that you can verify your account.

B. Search for your bank:

- If your bank appears in the search results, and click on the bank name and log in with your bank credentials to instantly verify your bank.

C. If your bank doesn't come up in the search:

- You will be walked through a couple of steps to verify your account based on a combination of login credentials and micro-deposits.
 - A micro-deposit is where the bank deposits a couple of small amounts into your account. Depending on the type of micro-deposit verification, you might need to manually verify your account on the same day you initiate the verification. You will need to log in to your bank verify each of the amounts deposited to your bank to complete the verification.



D. Once your bank account is verified, you can donate using that payment method.

Instant verification will allow you to donate that same day. However, micro-deposit verification might take a few days to complete, so you will need to complete your donation after you've finished that verification process.
